Policy 1960-2 defines the permanent mission of Project Negentropy as a confidential trust established to preserve human knowledge, productive capacity, and selected personnel during periods of severe disruption.

Dustin-Rhodes Corporation conducts Project Negentropy as a continuing institutional responsibility. Corporate profits not required for ordinary operations are directed to long-range preservation, research, training, and reserve industrial development.

The Project maintains protected archives, technical libraries, scientific instruments, manufacturing capability, agricultural resources, medical supplies, and specialized transportation systems.

Department 6 Troubleshooter teams are dispatched to investigate emerging conditions, assist threatened populations, recover scientific and cultural materials, and restore essential services when practical.

Project Negentropy preserves the technical means necessary to rebuild water systems, food production, communications, medicine, education, and industry.

The Project operates under strict confidentiality. Personnel are expected to exercise disciplined judgment, maintain respect for local populations, and employ resources for the long-term benefit of humanity.

The central obligation of Project Negentropy is to ensure that knowledge, tools, and trained people remain available when they are most needed.
